The present writ petition has been filed for directing the District Magistrate, Muzaffarpur to make payment of the admitted dues of a sum of Rs. 1,82,346/- which is stated to have been approved by the District Magistrate, Muzaffarpur on 31.03.2017 and it pertains to supply of food materials by the petitioner in the General Assembly Elections held in Bazar Samittee at Ahiyapur, Muzaffarpur.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be approaching the District Magistrate, Muzaffarpur for redressal of his aforesaid grievance.
