ORAL ORDER

2 28-02-2020 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Chautarwa P.S. Case No.266 of 2019 registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

As per allegation 500 ml of country made liquor was recovered from dicky of the motorcycle. It is alleged that motorcycle was used by Petitioner, Lallu Yadav.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is nothing incriminating has been recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner. He was falsely implicated in this case. He has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as



well as nature of accusation, in the event his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise , West Champaran at Bettiah in connection with Chautarwa P.S. Case No.266 of 2019 on the following conditions:

“(1) Petitioner shall cooperate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present, as directed by the Court and on his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail-bond shall be cancelled by the Court below.

(2) If the petitioner tamper with the evidence or the witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.”
