The petitioners are in custody in connection with
Industrial Area P.S. Case No. 186 of 2019, for the offence under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and they are in
custody since 19.11.2019. He further submits that in the instant
case total 100 litres of country made liquor was seized.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have got no



criminal antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. The petitioners, named above, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of 2nd Additional Sessions Judge -cum- Excise Court, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Industrial Area P.S. Case No. 186 of 2019.
