ORAL ORDER

4 13-07-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Saraiya P.S. Case No. 582 of 2019 for the offence punishable under Sections 363, 366(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence. These petitioners are woman and they have not played any role in the alleged occurrence. These petitioners have got clean antecedent. Hence, the petitioners may be granted the privilege of anticipatory bail.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioners in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks be released on bail on furnishing his personal bond to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-1st, (West) Muzaffarpur in connection with Saraiya P.S. Case No. 582 of 2019 subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
