2 23-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Jehanabad P.S.Case No.807 of 2019 , registered for offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 152, 153, 153(A), 307, 353 and 333 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution story is that large number of persons of two communities were engaged in the brick-batting on the Durga Pooja procession and the petitioners are also named in the FIR.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that except that they are named in the FIR, nothing specific has been attributed against them.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned CJM, Jehanabad in connection with Jehanabad P.S.Case No.807 of 2019, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

With the above direction, this application is allowed.
