The instant application has been filed for extension of



time to prefer appeal before the State Appellate Authority.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted one month time vide order dated 19.02.2018 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 9387 of 2016 to file appeal, but due to compelling circumstance, the petitioner could not prefer the appeal before the State Appellate Authority within the time granted by this Court.
