In paragraph 3 of the supplementary affidavit, the

annexed the cash receipts with the supplementary affidavit.

In view of the above, provisional anticipatory bail
allowed to the petitioner under order dated 28.1.2019 stands
confirmed, subject to the conditions laid down under section
438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

no. 2.
