2 23-01-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner is accused in connection with Paraiya P.S.
Case No. 85 of 2019 registered under Sections 302, 307, 504,
506/34 of the I.P.C. and 27 of the Arms Act.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is
that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. Petitioner is not named in the first information report.
Nothing has been alleged against the petitioner. There is specific
allegation against co-accused Pramod Kumar. It is also
submitted that petitioner is in custody since 27.07.2019.

Having considered the above facts and circumstances
of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on
furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M.-
III, Gaya in connection with Paraiya P.S. Case No. 85 of 2019.
