ORAL ORDER**

2 04-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in connection with Maniyari P.S. Case No. 246 of 2018 for the offence under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 353, 332, 427, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a), 38 and 41 of the Bihar Excise and Prohibition Act, 2016.

Allegation against the petitioner is that in the instant case approximately 600 litres liquor was seized.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and the liquor was seized from the house of co-accused Baliram Singh and not from the the house or possession of the petitioner.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and nothing was recovered from his conscious and



immediate possession, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.50,000/- (Fifty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge (Excise), Muzaffarpur in connection with Maniyari P.S. Case No. 246 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

In the event in future, if the petitioner is found to be involved in any such activities, the Court below shall be at liberty to cancel his bail bonds.
