Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 433 of 2019 for the offenses under Sections 504, 506, 387, 386 and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner in the instant case is that he has demanded ransom of Rs. 1,00,000/-. The petitioner is in custody since 16.08.2019.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has remained in custody for more than five months, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty



Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate II, Danapur, Patna, in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 433 of 2019, subject to the condition that one of the bailors shall be the family member of the petitioner.
