Petitioner has prayed for the following relief:-

“That this is an application for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari to quash/set aside the notice dated 30.11.2019 issued by and under the signature of respondent in-charge Officer, District Legal Section, Samastipur, whereby and whereunder, *inter alia* a show-cause has been asked to the petitioner in Confiscation Case No. 620/2019 directing the petitioner to show cause as to why the unnumbered



seized bullet motorcycle in connection with Tajpur (Waini O.P.) P.S. Case No. 371/09 bearing Chasis No. ME3U3S5C2KG587746, Engine No.- U3S5C2KG573570, although having its Registration No. BR33AJ 2711 (hereinafter referred to as the said vehicle), which has been seized with the foreign liquor be not confiscated under Section 58 of Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016 and further for issuance of a consequential writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding and directing the respondent authorities to release the said vehicle in favour of the petitioner.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

The instant petition stands disposed of as withdrawn.
