2      20-02-2020                      The petitioner is aggrieved by the non-inclusion of her name in the list of successful persons who have been granted license for Public Distribution Shops in Panchayat Chakhamid in the district of Begusarai.

After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition in order to enable the petitioner to pursue the representation preferred by her before the District Magistrate, Begusarai.



The aforesaid representation may be disposed off as an appeal against the aforesaid decision of the Committee which has not granted license to the petitioner.

It is expected that the District Magistrate, Begusarai (Respondent No. 3) shall dispose off the representation / appeal of the petitioner within a period of 60 days from the date of production/receipt of a copy of this order.
