

already been submitted. The name of the petitioner transpired in this case on the basis of disclosure, made by co-accused Manoj Kumar. Except for this, there is no other substantive evidence to suggest the implication of the petitioner in the present case.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and also the lockdown, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on his personal bond to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-Ist, Banka in connection with Sessions Trial No. 01 of 2017 arising out of Amarpur P.S. Case No. 110 of 2016.

Once the normalcy is restored, the petitioner shall furnish bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each within a period of four weeks to the satisfaction of the court concerned in connection with the aforesaid case.
