3 29-05-2020 Due to COVID-19 Pandemic, the matter is being taken up
by way of Virtual Court proceeding.

The matter has been listed under the heading 'For Orders'
under the orders of Hon'ble the Chief Justice.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 341, 323, 307, 427, 379, 324, 504, 506/34 of
the Indian Penal Code in which section 302 IPC was added later on.

The prosecution case in short is that the accused persons
came to the house of the informant and assaulted her due to which
she sustained and later in course of treatment, she died.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner is in custody since 21.11.2019. There is no allegation of
tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. Charge-sheet
has been submitted in the present case. As per the F.I.R., the



petitioner is said to have caused injury. The said injury is not a fatal injury. As per the post-mortem report, the death of the deceased was happened due to cardiogenic shock.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the lockdown, the petitioner above named, is directed to be released on bail on his personal bond to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in connection with Bakhri P.S. Case No. 375 of 2019.

Once the normalcy is restored, the petitioner shall furnish bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each within a period of four weeks to the satisfaction of the Court concerned in connection with the aforesaid case.
