2 03-02-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Amas
P.S. Case No. 237 of 2019, for the offence under Section 30(a)
of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody
since 25.12.2019. He further submits that in the instant case
total 40 litres of country made liquor was seized.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has got no
criminal antecedent and he has remained in custody for more
than two months, the Court is inclined to grant bail to him. The
petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on
furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five



thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Excise Gaya in connection with Amas P.S. Case No. 237 of 2019.
