Case No. 41 of 2019, registered for the offences punishable

Allegation is of recovery of 91 pieces of cartridges
from the house of the petitioner, apart from that he is accused in
10 other cases.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is

Considering the allegation and criminal antecedent, I
am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
