learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State through video

conferencing.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 304-B, 201/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Petitioner happens to be father in law of the victim and
is languishing in jail custody since 16.11.2019. No specific
allegation of assault as well as demand of dowry has been
levelled against the petitioner. Moreover, having similar
allegation, some co-accused have already been granted privilege
of bail by different Benches of this court.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as



well as taking note of this fact that petitioner is aged about 70 years, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Ravi Ranjan, learned Judicial Magistrate-1st Class, Begusarai in connection with Nayagaon P.S. Case No. 36 of 2018.
