counsel for the State.

Petitioner is accused in connection with Panapur P.S.
Case No. 246 of 2019 registered under Sections 30, 30(a), 38
and 41 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is
that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession
of the petitioner. It is also submitted that petitioner has no
criminal antecedent and is in custody since 27.12.2019.

Having considered the above facts and circumstances
of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on
