3 29-05-2020 Heard Mr. Viveka Nand Singh, learned counsel
for the petitioner and Mr. Ajit Kumar, APP for the State.

The petitioner, who is in custody since
16.12.2019, seeks bail in connection with Kotwali
(Tilkamanjhi) P.S. Case No. 807 of 2019 dated
12.09.2019 instituted for the offences under Sections
147, 148, 149, 447, 307, 387, 504 and 506 of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

As per the allegation in the FIR, about six to
seven persons surrounded the informant and also
opened fire for the purposes of obtaining protection
money from him.

Mr. Viveka Nand Singh, learned counsel for the
petitioner submits that there is no specific accusation



against the petitioner and except for his having been named in the FIR, nothing has been alleged against him.

Nobody has been injured in the occurrence. The background facts stated in the FIR, it has been argued, makes the prosecution version highly doubtful. One of the accused persons of this case viz. Paltu Yadav has been granted bail by a bench of this Court.

Considering the aforesaid facts, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur in connection with Kotwali (Tilkamanjhi) P.S. Case No. 807 of 2019.
