The petitioner is in custody in connection with Belaganj P.S. Case No. 05 of 2020 for the offenses under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. In the instant case total 80 kgs of mahua flower was recovered from the motorcycle. The petitioner is in custody since 06.01.2020.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
