The petitioner is in custody in connection with  
Baikunthpur P.S. Case No. 206 of 2017 for the offenses under  
Sections 341, 323, 379, 504, 506, 427 and 34 of the Indian  
Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Allegation against the  
petitioner in the instant case is that he, along with other accused  
persons, was involved in assaulting the informant and snatched  
the motorcycle and cash from the informant. Learned counsel  
for the petitioner further submits that there is no specific overt  
act alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody  
since 02.12.2019.



Considering the fact that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and no specific overt act is alleged against the petitioner, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sri R.M. Tiwari, Judicial Magistrate I<sup>st</sup> Class, Gopalganj, in connection with Baikunthpur P.S. Case No. 206 of 2017.
