Case No. 400 of 2019 registered for the offence punishable
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this
case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious
possession of this petitioner. Petitioner has no concern with
the seized article. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.
