2 03-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Itarhi P.S. Case No.265 of 2019, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 323, 341, 324, 379, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners and the informant are neighbours. The dispute is with respect to construction of stair, led to scuffle and assault. From the impugned order, it appears that nature of injury is simple.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, above-named, be released on



anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-6, Buxar, in connection with Itarhi P.S. Case no.265 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
