3 02-09-2020 This case has been heard through video conferencing.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Section 498A of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the D.P. Act.

Allegation upon the petitioner is of committing torture
upon the informant for non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed a
supplementary affidavit stating therein that case has been
compromised on the point of one time settlement. On the basis



of compromise, Maintenance Case No. 379 of 2017 has been disposed off on 14.01.2020 by the court of Principal Judge, Family Court at Motihari which is annexed as Annexure-A to the supplementary affidavit.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Complaint Case No. C-2403 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
