counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioners are in custody in connection with Pipra
P.S. Case No. 383 of 2019 for the offence under section 392 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
petitioners have no criminal antecedent and they were not
named in the FIR. Their names surfaced on the confessional
statement of the co-accused.

The petitioners are in custody since 30.11.2019.

Considering the fact that petitioners have no criminal
antecedent and they were not named in the FIR, the Court is



inclined to grant bail to the petitioners, let the petitioners, named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran, in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No. 383 of 2019.
