Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in connection with Sono P.S. Case No.182 of 2017 for offences under Sections 143, 145, 147, 149, 150, 152, 186, 353, 323, 332, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

It is alleged that the petitioner is known to the police for protesting and blocking Sono Chowk. It is further alleged that approximately 150-200 persons assembled on the road and stopped the police personnel in discharging their duties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner was among the people demonstrating against failure of system, this Court is inclined to



grant bail to him. Let petitioner, above-named, in the event of arrest or surrender within one month from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-1st, Jamui in connection with Sono P.S. Case No.182 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
