2 02-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in connection with Warisnagar (Mathurapur O.P.) P.S. Case No. 340 of 2019 for the offence under Sections 307, 341, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Although there is allegation of indiscriminate firing, no one has sustained injury and there is no material to suggest that firing took place. He further submits that on account of business rivalry, petitioner has been made accused in the present case.



Considering the fact that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and no one has sustained injury, the Court is inclined to grant bail to petitioner, in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.50,000/- (Fifty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate Samastipur in connection with Warisnagar (Mathurapur O.P.) P.S. Case No. 340 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
