Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of taking Rs. 9,754/- from the customers instead of prescribed price of Rs. 8,298/- for selling the sand.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case due to ill motive. He submits that there is allegation of taking more money from the customer. He further submits that petitioner bears no criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the



petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M. 1st Class, Danapur in connection with Ranitalab Police Station Case No. 14 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
