ORAL ORDER

3 25-06-2020 The present petition has been taken up for consideration through the mode of Video Conferencing in view of the prevailing situation on account of COVID-19 Pandemic.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Jamhore PS case no. 96 of 2019 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 307 and other allied sections of Indian Penal Code.

The allegation is regarding the petitioners and other accused persons having assaulted the informant as also having



snatched his golden chain.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent, have been falsely implicated in the present case and are having clean antecedent. It is further submitted that the doctor has found the injuries on the person of the informant to be simple in nature. It is further submitted that the present case arises out of case and counter case.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, considering the submissions of the learned counsel for the parties and taking into account the fact that the injuries found on the person of the informant are simple in nature and the petitioners are having clean antecedent, I deem it fit and appropriate to admit the petitioners to the privilege of anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the abovenamed petitioners, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/ production of a copy of this order, are directed to be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Aurangabad in connection with Jamhore PS case no. 96 of 2019 subject to the conditions



as laid down under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal
Procedure.
