3 03-06-2020 Heard Mr. Rudal Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Shilendra Kumar, learned counsel for the State as well as Mr. Sudhir Kumar, learned counsel for the informant.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection with S.Tr. No.615 of 2019, arising from Ashthawan P.S. Case No.134 of 2019 registered for offence punishable under sections 304(B)/201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The marriage of the victim was solemnized with the present petitioner and during marriage, the informant had given gift of Rs.3,00,000/- to the petitioner and whereafter they demanded Rs.50,000/- and one motor cycle. When the demand was not fulfilled, the victim lady has been killed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the



petitioner is husband of the victim lady and at the relevant time, he was not there, but looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner for the present.

Accordingly, this bail application is dismissed.
