ORAL ORDER

5 25-08-2020 It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that during pendency of the application for grant of bail, the police completed investigation and submitted charge-sheet under Section 304A of the Indian Penal Code, which is bailable in nature. He contended that since charge-sheet was submitted under bailable offence, the petitioner has already been granted bail by the court below.

In view of the submissions made above, the application is disposed of as infructuous.

Since the court proceedings are being conducted through virtual mode and normal court functioning has not been restored till date, it is considered appropriate to adopt the following procedure for communication of the present order:-
