ORAL ORDER

3 15-06-2020 Mr. Pramod Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that during the pendency of the writ application, the petitioner's grievance has been substantially redressed. He, however, submits that the petitioner has in fact not been paid differential amount, she is duly entitled to against such heads for which she may be granted liberty to approach the respondent-University by making a representation.

Considering the aforesaid submission, this application



is disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to approach the authority, if according to her, the amount which has been paid against various heads is less than from what she is actually entitled to. If she makes representation within two months from today, the same shall be considered and disposed of within two months thereafter.

This application stands disposed of.
