The petitioner seeks bail in Amarpur P.S. Case No.579 of 2018, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

The gist of the allegation is that the petitioner got appointment on the post of teacher on the basis of forged and fabricated certificate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner got 450 marks in the examination held by Bihar Sanskrit Shiksha Board. An enquiry was conducted and it was held that the certificate issued in favour of the petitioner is forged one. The petitioner is not responsible for getting such forged certificate.

Considering the facts and nature of allegations made against the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner being a lady is



in jail since 15.11.2019 and she has remained in jail for about 3½ months, petitioner, namely, Indu Kumari @ Indu Devi is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka in connection with Amarpur P.S. Case No.579 of 2018.
