learned APP for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection with Gobindganj (Malahi) P.S. Case No. 01 of 2018, registered for the offence under Sections 304B, 201, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is the husband of the deceased. Allegation has been made against the accused persons including this petitioner to have killed the deceased on account of non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the deceased died of natural death but, when this Court has asked whether the deceased was suffering from any ailment, learned



counsel for the petitioner has failed to explain the situation in what manner she died.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the prayer for bail is rejected.
