ORAL ORDER

3 10-12-2020 This matter has been taken up in virtual court.

Let the defects be removed within two weeks of
the start of the physical Court.

Heard the parties.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a
case registered for the offence punishable under Sections
307/324/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the background and nature of
allegation against the petitioners, especially non commission of
injury on any vital part of the body, let the petitioners, above
named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court
below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of



the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Bettiah Town P.S. Case No. 747 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.

(c) The petitioners shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
