4      05-06-2020                      The matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

The FIR of the occurrence of robbery is against unknown. Petitioner is in custody since 05.11.2019. Investigation of the case is already complete against the petitioner. Only material against the petitioner is confessional statement of co-accused Prince Kumar before the police.

Submission is that nothing was recovered from possession of the petitioner nor the petitioner was put on T.I. Parade. Co-accused has already been allowed bail by a Coordinate



Bench of this Court in Cr. Misc. No. 7155 of 2020.

Considering the entire facts aforesaid and completion of investigation of the case against the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Pupri Police Station Case No. 382 of 2019, subject to the following conditions:-

(a) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the learned court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(b) Both the bailors shall be resident of the territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the learned court below.

If the petitioner would not be able in furnishing sureties due to lockdown, he shall be provisionally released on his personal bond and the provisional bail shall be confirmed only after production of the bailors within fifteen days of restoration of normal function of the Court.
