ORAL ORDER

3 13-05-2020 Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as

well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State

through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Case No.
C2/760/19 registered for the offences punishable under Sections
30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The accusation against the petitioner is that he was
caught by the officials of SSB, while he was carrying 260 litres
of Nepali wine. Petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent
and is languishing in jail custody since 21.12.2019.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as
well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner, above
named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.



10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Sitamarhi/concerned court in connection with Case No. C2/760/19.

However, it is made clear that if the petitioner fails to make available sureties due to lock down as well as due to prevailing situation, the concerned court shall release the petitioner provisionally on personal bond with condition that petitioner shall furnish the sureties when lock down is over.
