The petitioner seeks bail in Pipra P.S. Case No.58 of 2019, registered under Sections 25(1-b) 1A/26/35 of the Arms Act.

One Md. Meraj Imam @ Rinku was apprehended and on the basis of his confessional statement one carbine and 12 live cartridges were recovered from a room of the petitioner taken on rent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in jail since 18.05.2019. Md. Meraj Imam @ Rinku has falsely implicated the petitioner on account of enmity. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody for about nine months.

Considering the facts that the petitioner has got no



criminal antecedent and he has remained in jail for about nine months, petitioner, namely, Md. Firoz Natt is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District Judge-V, Patna in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No.58 of 2019, giving rise to S. Tr. No.930 of 2019, subject to the condition that one of the bailors shall be father or mother of the petitioner having substantial immovable property in his or her name.
