2 28-02-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the offences under Sections 376, 511 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case in short is that the accused person ill-treated with the informant and tried to outrage her modesty.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 26.10.2019 and has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. Charge-sheet has been submitted in the present case. The alleged occurrence is said to have taken place in the night. No source of identification has



been given. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case due to village politics.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R..

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. VI, Katihar in connection with Mansahi P.S. Case No. 42 of 2018.
