2 02-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case for the offence
registered under Sections 399, 402 of the IPC and 25(1-b)a, 26
and 35 of the Arms Act.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that the police
during the course of patrolling, apprehended four criminals
including the petitioner Deepak Kumar with two motorcycles
and from possession of Deepak Kumar (petitioner), one loaded
country made pistol was recovered.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner is languishing in custody since
07.07.2019. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. He



has falsely been implicated in the present case. Charge sheet has been submitted in the present case. There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against the petitioner. One loaded country made pistol is said to have been recovered from possession of the petitioner. There is no compliance of Section 100 of Cr. P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Madhepura, in connection with Singheshwar P.S. Case No. 155 of 2019.
