42.480 litres of liquor is said to have been

recovered from a motorcycle which was being driven by

the petitioners.

The petitioners have a different story to

narrate. It is their version that the motorcycle belongs to

another person and only because there was some

altercation with the local police with respect to non-



possession of certain compulsory certificates like pollution certificate etc., the petitioners have been made accused in this case.

The petitioners are in custody since 05.01.2020.

In any view of the matter, considering the nature of accusation against the petitioners, their clean antecedents and the period of custody, they are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousands) with sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge (Excise), Banka in connection with Excise Complaint Case No. 03 of 2020.
