2 06-03-2020 The short grievance of the petitioner in the present case is that despite the petitioner having filed objection under Section 9 of the Bihar and Orissa Public Demands Recovery Act, 1914 before the learned Certificate Officer, Vaishali in connection with Certificate Case No. 3 of 2017-18, the learned Certificate Officer, Vaishali is not passing the final orders under Section 10 of the Bihar and Orissa Public Demands Recovery Act, 1914, and instead, has issued a distress warrant.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to direct the Certificate Officer, Vaishali to consider the objection already filed by the petitioner under Section 9 of the Bihar and Orissa Public Demand



Recovery Act, 1914, if any, and pass the final orders under Section 10 of the Bihar and Orissa Public Demands Recovery Act, 1914 in connection with Certificate Case No. 3 of 2017-18 and till passing of such final orders, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner.

The present writ petition stands disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
