The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under  
Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that four unknown miscreants snatched  
the bike of the informant

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that  
the petitioner is in custody since 7.9.2019. Charge sheet has  
been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering  
of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is not  
named in the F.I.R. His name has come on disclosure made by  
co-accused. There is no recovery of any incriminating article  
from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has not been  
put on T.I.P.



On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Deepak Kumar, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> class, Muzaffarpur in connection with Ahiyapur P.S. case No.918 of 2019.
