This application has been filed for restoration of Cr. Misc. No. 50921 of 2019, which stood dismissed due to non-compliance of peremptory order, dated 04.11.2019, whereunder the petitioner was directed to take steps for fresh service of notice upon opposite party no. 2 by both processes, under ordinary post as well as under registered cover with A/D, on her correct and present address, within four weeks.
