ORAL ORDER

2 29-02-2020 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
the offence under Sections 398 and 307 of the Indian Penal
Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has not
committed any offence. In fact, the co-accused having more
or less similar allegation has already been granted regular
bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in Cr. Misc. No.
16411 of 2019 and Cr. Misc. No. 24084 of 2019 and the case
of this petitioner stands on similar footing. The petitioner is
rotting in judicial custody since 19.10.2018. Hence, the



petitioner may be enlarged on regular bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the, above named, petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge- IV, Jamui, in connection with S.T. No. 142 of 2019 arising out of Jhajha P.S. Case No. 68 of 2017.
