The petitioner, who is the husband of the complainant,
is apprehending arrest in connection with Complaint Case No.
1066 of 2018 for offences under Section 498A of the Indian
Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he has
tortured opposite party no. 2 for non-fulfillment of dowry
demand.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the



petitioner has no criminal antecedent and marriage between the petitioner and opposite party no. 2 took place 27.06.2012. The petitioner is ready to keep his wife (opposite party no. 2) with full honour and dignity.

Considering the aforesaid and in order to promote normalcy in restoration of conjugal life between the petitioner and opposite party no.2, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Let petitioner, above-named, in the event of arrest or surrender within one month from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-XVI, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Complaint Case No. 1066 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

In the event the petitioner neglects, misbehaves or torture the complainant (opposite party no. 2), the court below shall be at liberty to cancel his bail bond.
