2 04-03-2020 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Piro (Hasan Bazar) P.S. Case No 250 of 2019 Registered for the offences under sections 406, 420/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner is Manager of Dakshin Bihar Gramin Bank. He found that Rs. 1, 51, 843/- has been siphoned off from the account of Kanchan Kumari and Radhika Kumari. It is further alleged that Assistant Manager inquired the matter and reported that Office Assistant Dharmendra Kumar and Sanoj Yadav using user E.M.P. ID and by seeding wrong Aadhar in different account did illegal withdrawal of money.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that immediately after discovering the illegal withdrawal of money, petitioner lodged the FIR against the persons responsible for that. There is no complicity of the petitioner who is the Manager



of the Branch. In course of internal inquiry conducted by the Bank the complicity of the petitioner is not found. It is submitted that co-accused Sameer Kumar has already deposited the alleged amount of defalcation in the bank and the same has been transferred in concerned account of customer from whose account alleged money was fraudulently withdrawn.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as nature of accusation, in the event of his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur, Ara in connection with Piro (Hasan Bazar) P.S. Case No. 250 of 2019 , subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.
