Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in Saharsa

Sadar P.S. Case No. 1060/2019 registered for the offence under



Sections 341/323/354/384/379/504/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Case and counter case have been filed between the parties. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that petitioner no. 1 has filed Complaint Case No. 69/2020 and in retaliation these petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. There is general and omnibus demand of *rangdari* and no theft has been committed.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as nature of accusation, in the event their arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the above named petitioners be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saharsa in connection with Saharsa Sadar P.S. Case No. 1060/2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.
