Since retiral benefits and 90% pension have already been ordered to be paid to the petitioner and remaining 10% pension amount is withheld in view of provision as contained in Rule 43(b) of Bihar Pension Rules, on account of pendency of the criminal case, I find that this writ petition has become infructuous.

This writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of as has become infructuous.
