2 29-06-2020 Due to COVID-19 Pandemic, the matter is being taken
up by way of virtual Court proceeding.

The matter has been listed under the heading “For Orders”
under the orders of Hon’ble the Chief Justice.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for
the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered
under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, the accused persons committed illegality in the
appointment of teachers in Niyojan Year 2008 by manipulating the
roll Nos. of applicants and in this manner, the some genuine persons
entitled for appointment (Niyojan) on the post of teachers, were
discriminated.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there is no
allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner.



The petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. The petitioner is a retired Panchayat Secretary. No irregularities were committed by him. There is no role of the petitioner for gain or loss in the Niyojan, in question. The petitioner has been made accused in the present case due to mistake of fact.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and also the lockdown, the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on his personal bond to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Nautan P.S. Case No. 170 of 2019 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Once the normalcy is restored, the petitioner shall furnish bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each within a period of seven weeks to the satisfaction of the court concerned in connection with the aforesaid case.
